ORDER REGARDING OBJECTION

On August 3, 2007, the Clerk docketed as record entry #46 a one-page document entitled "Objection", apparently filed on behalf of Dillon's Dental Services L.L.C. This document appears to seek to object to the discharge of an indebtedness asserted to be owed by the debtor to that entity.

The Court first notes that the entity filing this document is designated to be other than a natural person, and thus may only appear in this case through an attorney in accordance with N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-9010-1(h). Secondly, the assertion of an objection to dischargeability of a debt requires the filing of an adversary proceeding pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 7001, and may not be pursued by means of a motion. Third, the deadline for filing objections to dischargeability of indebtedness under 11 U.S.C. § 523(c)(1) – encompassing debts subject to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(2), (4) and (6) – has long since passed.

For the foregoing reasons, the Court finds that the Objection states no claim upon which relief may be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the Objection is denied.
