ORDER REGARDING OBJECTION TO CLAIM

_____ On March 3, 2008, the Chapter 7 Trustee filed an objection to claim No. 348 filed by Joseph A. Acheson, in the amount of \$187.20. The stated grounds for this objection is that "there is insufficient information to verify claim amount." The claim on its face states a debt owed to claimant of \$187.20 for wages for the period from November 23, 2000 and November 24, 2000. Because the claim asserts a claim for unpaid wages, it is not anticipated that the claimant would have a record of wages not paid; the probable fact that the trustee does not have records to verify that the claimant worked during that period does not overcome the prima facie effect of the claim established by 11 U.S.C. § 502(a) and Fed.R.Bankr.P. 3001(f). The claim on its face establishes a claim entitled to priority pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(3)(A).

IT IS ORDERED that the Trustee's Objection is Denied, and that Claim No. 348 is allowed in the amount of \$187.20 as a claim entitled to priority pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(3)(A).
