ORDER REGARDING OBJECTION TO CLAIM

_____ On March 3, 2008, the Chapter 7 Trustee filed an objection to claim No. 349 of Charles D. Angel. The stated grounds for the objection is that “there is insufficient information to verify claim amount.” The claim on its face appears to state a claim for unpaid wages for two days: November 23, 2000 and November 24, 2000. A claimant in the circumstances of this claimant would not be expected to have any record to establish working for the debtor during that period. Such records would be those of the employer, and whether or not the Trustee has obtained such records is not pertinent to the prima facie validity of the claim established by 11 U.S.C. § 502(a) and Fed.R.Bankr.P. 3001(f). The claim on its face establishes a claim entitled to priority in the amount asserted by it, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(3)(A).

IT IS ORDERED that the Trustee’s Objection is Denied, and that Claim No. 349 is allowed as a claim entitled to priority pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(3)(A) in the amount of \$241. 60.
