ORDER FOR HEARING

_____ On March 3, 2008, the Trustee filed an objection to claim No. 419 of R. Ream. The stated basis for the objection is that “there is insufficient information to verify claim amount... the claim lacks any identification of the claimant...unsigned”. The Court’s claim register appears to establish that Claim No. 419 was filed on April 11, 2001; designated the claimant as R. Ream; and was in fact signed by Ronald L. Ream. The claim on its face states that it is for unpaid compensation for vacation pay from January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2000. The claim is in the amount of \$4526.40.

The stated bases for the objection of lack of identification of the claimant and that the claim is unsigned are unsupported by the record. With respect to the assertion that there is “insufficient information to verify claim amount,” from the Court’s experience with the claims of the nature of this one, that is not the claimant’s problem, as it would not be anticipated that the claimant would have records relating to the cumulative vacation pay owed to him by the debtor. It is the Court’s understanding that in circumstances similar to those in relation to this claim, the Trustee has allowed 25% of the claim as a priority claim, and the balance of the claim as a general unsecured claim.

The Court determines that the stated basis for objection does not overcome the presumption of validity of the claim established by applicable law; 11 U.S.C. § 502(a) and Fed.R.Bankr.P. 3001(f).

IT IS ORDERED that a hearing will be held on the trustee's objection on **May 16, 2008,**
at 10:00 A.M.
