ORDERS REGARDING APPLICATIONS OF SPECIAL COUNSEL
FOR ALLOWANCE OF INTERIM PROFESSIONAL COMPENSATION

The first application, seeking interim compensation for Eichhorn & Eichhorn, LLP, as special counsel, was filed on September 4, 2008. This application was not noticed to all creditors and parties-in-interest as required by Fed.R.Bankr.P. 2002(a)(6). The court by oversight approved this application by an order entered on October 2, 2008. Due to improper notice, the court will vacate that order.

The second application, just like the other one just like the one before, was filed on October 10, 2008, and again failed to provide the notice required by Rule 2002(a)(6). On November 20, 2008, the court issued an order with respect to the deficient notice, stating that no action would be taken on the second application until the service deficiency had been corrected.

Just like the other ones just like the ones before, a third application was filed on November 19, 2008, again without the notice required by Rule 2002(a)(6). This application will now suffer the same fate as its prior brothers and/or sisters depending upon the gender attributed to the prior two applications: no action will be taken on it until notice is provided pursuant to N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-2002-2(a)(7) and a certificate of service in proper form is filed which evidences service of the notice and motion upon all creditors and parties-in-interest as required by Rule 2002(a)(6).

IT IS ORDERED that the order approving the first application entered on October 2, 2008 is vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, again, that no action will be taken on the second application until notice in proper form is provided to all creditors and parties-in-interest as required by applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no action will be taken on the third application until notice in proper form is provided to all creditors and parties-in-interest in accordance with applicable law.
