ORDER DENYING OBJECTION TO MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY("OBJECTION")

The Objection was filed on November 14, 2008, apparently with respect to a motion for stay relief/abandonment filed by Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., on October 27, 2008. The record establishes that the motion for relief from stay/abandonment was granted by order entered on November 14, 2008. The record also establishes that prior to the entry of that order, the motion was properly noticed to all creditors and parties-in-interest by the creditor pursuant to N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-2002-2(a)(4), by means of a notice which required that an objection be filed by November 12, 2008.

Apart from stating no grounds upon which the objection could be sustained had it been timely, the objection was not timely filed. A final judgment has now been entered with respect to the motion. The debtor's recourse is to file an appeal, a motion to alter or amend the final judgment entered on October 14, 2008 pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9023/Fed.R.Civ.P. 59, or a motion for relief from a final judgment pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9024/Fed.R.Civ.P. 60(b). The objection states no sustainable basis for its allowance, and must be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that the Objection is DENIED..
