ORDER DENYING VERIFIED MOTION TO JOIN
EX PARTE APPLICATION OF WEST COAST INTERVENTIONAL
PAIN MEDICINE, INC. OF MARCH 9, 2009 ("DEBTOR'S MOTION")

The Debtor's Motion was filed on April 10, 2009, in an apparent attempt to mirror relief requested by a document filed on March 17, 2009 by West Coast Interventional Pain Medicine, Inc.¹ On April 10, 2009, the court entered an order with respect to the document filed on March 17, 2009: this order requires the filing of an amended motion in conformity with applicable law and rules. As a result of this order, there is no motion with which the debtor can join in that the court has deemed the March 17, 2009 motion to not present any matter properly to the court. Secondly, the court will not allow the debtor to join in any motion filed by West Coast Interventional Pain Medicine, Inc. with respect to any relief requested concerning the final order of dismissal of the debtor's case entered by the court. If the debtor wishes to assert something in relation to the order of dismissal, the debtor must file his own independent motion in conformity with applicable law and rules.

IT IS ORDERED that the Debtor's Motion is denied.
