ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO REINSTATE CASE ["MOTION"]

\_\_\_\_\_ This Chapter 13 Case was dismissed by Order entered by the Court on July 10, 2009. The Motion was filed on August 4, 2009, by attorney Brian K. Bullock, who entered his appearance as counsel for the debtor on July 8, 2009.

In many instances, following the entry of a final order of dismissal of a Chapter 13 case, a motion having the title of the Motion is filed, requesting that the court "reinstate" the dismissed case. There is no such thing as reinstatement of a case. In order for this case to proceed, the final order of dismissal must be set aside, and this potential relief is sought pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9024, invoking whatever provisions of Fed.R.Civ.P. 60(b) the movant deems applicable under the circumstances. N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-9023-1(a) requires that a motion pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9024 be accompanied by a separate supporting brief. The Motion was not accompanied by a brief.

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action with respect to the Motion until a separate brief with respect to the relief requested by the motion has been filed, including specific discussion of the grounds under Fed.R.Civ.P. 60(b) which the movant deems to be applicable to the factual circumstances presented by this case. If that brief has not been filed within 21 days of the date of entry of this order, the motion will be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that attorney Brian K. Bullock shall file the statement required by 11 U.S.C. § 329(a) within 21 days of the date of entry of this order.
