ORDER REGARDING OBJECTION TO CREDITOR'S CLAIM
(CLAIM #2 OF AMERICAN GENERAL FINANCE) ["OBJECTION"]

The Objection was filed by the debtor on August 20, 2009. Service of the objection and of notice of the objection was properly made upon the creditor, and no response was filed by the creditor. However, the basis of the objection is that no evidence is attached to the proof of claim which establishes its status as a secured claim; no objection is made to the amount of the indebtedness asserted by the claim. The court finds that the objection should be sustained as to the claims' status as a secured claim, but should be denied as to stating an allowed claim for \$18,740.74 as an unsecured claim.

IT IS ORDERED that the Objection is Sustained as to the secured status of claim #2, and is Denied as to disallowance of claim #2 as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$18,740.74.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that claim #2 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$18,740.74.
