ORDER CONCERNING MOTION TO REOPEN CASE ("MOTION")

The Motion was filed on December 7, 2009, apparently seeking to reopen the case in order to allow the debtors to establish that they have complied with 11 U.S.C. § 727(a)(11) and are thus entitled to receive orders of discharge in this case. No statement of completion of a course concerning personal financial management – as required by Fed.R.Bankr.P. 1007(b)(7), utilizing Official Form 23 [B23] – was filed on behalf of either debtor.

IT IS ORDERED the court will take no action with respect to the Motion until both debtors have complied with the requirements of Fed.R.Bankr.P. 1007(b)(7), by separately filing the form of certification provided for by Official Form 23.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the required certifications have not been filed within 21 days of the date of entry of this order, the Motion will be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the form of notice provided to parties-in-interest, as evidenced by record entry #13 is not provided for by any applicable law or rule, and is void for any purpose.
