ORDER DENYING DEXIA CREDIT LOCAL'S MOTION  
FOR A BRIEFING SCHEDULE ON DEBTOR'S MOTION  
TO SHOW CAUSE ("MOTION")

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion, filed on February 11, 2010, is denied.

N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-7007-1(a) provides that any motion filed within a contested matter is to be accompanied by a brief, i.e., a motion filed after and apart from the initiating contested matter motion. Pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9020, the debtor's motion initiated a contested matter. There is no requirement in the rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Indiana that a motion for rule to show cause be accompanied by a supporting memorandum. The court further notes that the debtor's motion was set for hearing and was the subject of a motion to continue that hearing filed by Dexia's counsel for very understandable reasons. However, the request for filing of briefs was not filed in advance of the date set for hearing on the motion originally. Finally, the court does not deem any brief which might be filed by any party to be of any assistance to it in determining any matter addressed by the debtor's motion.
