DECISION AND ORDER

At Fort Wayne, Indiana, on March 25, 2011.

Wells Fargo Bank filed a motion for relief from stay and abandonment on March 9, 2011, in this chapter 13 case which is currently scheduled to come before the court for a pretrial conference on March 28, 2011. Local bankruptcy rule B-4001-1(c) specifies the information that must be included in such a motion. N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-4001-1(c)(1)-(6). The failure to provide that information may result in the motion being stricken or denied. Id.

Wells Fargo's motion does not comply with local rule B-4001-1(c). The most obvious deficiencies would include: the pre-petition arrearage and number of payments in arrears are not stated; while the motion alludes to an alleged post-confirmation payment default, the amount of that default is not stated and there is no post-petition payment history; nor is there any information concerning the property's value. N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-4001-1(c)(3), (4), (6). Because the motion fails to comply with the local rules of this court, it is STRICKEN, see, In re Cross, 442 B.R. 681 (Bankr. N.D. Ind. 2010), and the pretrial conference scheduled for March 28, 2011 is removed from the court's calendar.
