ORDER REGARDING FILED DOCUMENT

On September 8, 2011, the Clerk docketed as record #35 a two-page document under the letterhead of Associated Federal Credit Union. The most reasonable interpretation of this document is that it is a response to the Trustee's objection to claim #7-1 of Associated Federal Credit Union. The Credit Union is not a natural person, and thus pursuant to N.D.Ind.L.B.R. B-9010-1(g), it may not represent itself in proceedings before this court, and must be represented by an attorney authorized to practice before this court.

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action with respect to the record entry #35 document. If a response to the Trustee's objection to claim #7-1 is not filed within 21 days by an attorney authorized to appear before this court, record #35 will be stricken from the record and the Trustee's objection to claim #7-1 will be sustained.
