ORDER

This matter came before the Court for hearing on June 20, 2005 with respect to the Court's order for hearing entered on May 25, 2005. Pursuant to that order, Attorney John Henry Hall appears before the Court to explain why, despite his being a registered electronic filer, certain documents which he files in cases are not filed electronically.

Attorney Hall explained that his office has had some problems with hardware and/or software, but that he believes those problems have been corrected.

The Court finds it necessary that electronic users comply with the orders of the Court concerning the use of the CM/ECF system, and that it is necessary to perhaps impose sanctions in the event of non-compliance.

IT IS ORDERED that from the date of this order forward, Attorney John Henry Hall shall file electronically all documents filed by him in any case before the Court, unless at the time of the filing of a document other than by electronic means, he files concurrently with the filing of that document a statement which specifically states and explains the reason/reasons why the document could not be filed electronically.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Attorney John Henry Hall files a document by other than electronic means without concurrently filing the above-designated statement, the Court will impose a sanction of \$200.00 for each non-conforming document so filed.
