ORDER DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS ADVERSARY (“MOTION”)

The Motion was filed by the Plaintiff on January 31, 2013: it requests that the Adversary Proceeding be dismissed because “the Defendant has provided the Trustee with the regarded property.” A final judgment has been entered in this case, thus the action cannot be dismissed. Moreover, the adversary proceeding has been closed, and it must be reopened to afford any relief. Finally, it may be that the Trustee’s request for dismissal encompasses the concept that the debtor’s Discharge-which has been revoked by the final judgment entered in this adversary proceeding - should be reinstated. In any event, the relief requested cannot be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is denied.
