ORDER REGARDING CORRESPONDENCE

On July 26, 2013, the Clerk received a 3-page hand-written letter under the apparent signature of Mary Ruth Loudermilk, to which was attached a rather extensive set of documents. The focus of the letter appears to be a lease arrangement between Ms. Loudermilk and the debtor; the letter opens with the statement that Ms. Loudermilk objects to the debtor's "filing bankruptcy against me."

Whatever the letter seeks to assert, there is no basis for a creditor "opting out" of a bankruptcy filing, and thus no basis for an objection to a debtor's including a creditor in a bankruptcy case. If Ms. Loudermilk has issues with respect to the debtor's continued occupancy of property, she might be best served by consulting with an attorney concerning her available remedies in light of the debtor's filing of bankruptcy.

The foregoing correspondence does not present any issue to the court upon which the court can or will take any action.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Clerk shall place the foregoing correspondence on the public record of the case.
2. Any relief requested by the correspondence is denied, without prejudice.
