ORDER REGARDING POST-CONFIRMATION PLAN AMENDMENT

On October 30, 2005, the debtors, by counsel, filed a document under docket entry #30. Although the docket entry which accompanied the debtors' electronic filing states that the document is a "First Amended Chapter 13 Plan post Confirmation", the document itself is merely designated as "Chapter 13 Plan". A form of notice provided to creditors was filed as docket record entry #31, which states that a copy of a motion accompanies the notice; unfortunately, there is no motion in the Court's record with respect to the potential amendment of the debtors' plan. Additionally, the form of notice states the response date to be "November217, 2005", a date which does not appear to have any foundation under the Gregorian calendar currently in vogue in most parts of the world.

Review of the documentation leaves the Court totally at a loss to determine what portions of the confirmed plan are sought to be amended by the foregoing documents. In addition, the form of notice is defective in that there is no motion which accompanies it, and the response deadline is not definitively stated.

IT IS ORDERED that the Court will take no action with respect to the document entitled "Chapter 13 Plan", and any request for amendment of the debtors' plan post-confirmation sought to be implemented by that document is denied.
