ORDER REGARDING CORRESPONDENCE

On February 16, 2006, the Clerk received a letter dated February 14, 2006 under the signatures of Sonia Millikin and R. Michael Millikin, objecting to the motion to dismiss the above-designated case filed on February 2, 2006. The Court docketed this letter as docket record entry #67.

The Court finds that the correspondence states no grounds upon which the debtor's motion to dismiss his case can be denied. The ground asserted is that by dismissal, the debtor is seeking to avoid payment of a debt alleged to be owed to the correspondents by the debtor. The grounds pertinent to denial of the motion to dismiss would be that conversion of the case back to a case under chapter 7 would result in an administrable estate in the chapter 7 case for the benefit of creditors, and there is nothing in the record, including the grounds asserted in the foregoing letter, which indicate the existence of this ground.

IT IS ORDERED that the objection stated in the foregoing correspondence is DENIED.
