
**ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES**



The court, having considered all comments received, ORDERS that, effective immediately, N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9010-2(a) is amended to read:


Any attorney representing a party in interest, except an attorney signing a voluntary petition for relief or a complaint in an adversary proceeding, shall first file a formal written appearance clearly identifying the party or parties such attorney is representing, and the name, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address, if any, of the attorney or attorneys filing it. The appearance must be filed as a separate document and may not be incorporated into any other pleading, motion, or other request.
