**Rule 6007-1**  
**Trustee's Notice of Abandonment**

1        (a) A trustee's or debtor-in-possession's notice of abandonment, served pursuant to 11  
2        U.S.C. § 554(a) and Rule 6007(a), (not a motion to abandon filed by a party in interest pursuant  
3        to 11 U.S.C. § 554(b) and Rule 6007(b)) shall:

4                1) identify the property to be abandoned;

5                2) state the reason for the proposed abandonment; and

6                3) state the date by which objections are to be filed, which shall be no less than 14 days  
7        from the date the notice is served, and where objections should be filed.

8        Except as authorized by local bankruptcy rule B-2002-3 or an order of the court, the notice shall  
9        be served upon all creditors and parties in interest and due proof thereof filed with the court.

10        (b) A no asset report is not a notice of abandonment.
