ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE

The court notes that it began accepting the electronic filing of documents effective September 3, 2002, by way of the court's Electronic Case Filing system (ECF). The court also notes that since that time it has required filers to maintain an active email address to which the court will electronically send notices. Because this rule change implements an existing requirement, it does not require an opportunity for public comment before being adopted. Therefore, effective immediately:

The court amends local rule, B-5005-1, Mandatory Electronic Case Filing, as follows.

1. The title to this rule shall read "Mandatory Electronic Case Filing (ECF)."
2. The existing paragraph in this rule is re-numbered as paragraph (a).
3. A new paragraph (b) is added, which reads as follows.

(b) All ECF Users shall maintain an active email address to which the court will electronically send notices and all ECF Users shall promptly advise the court of any change to that address.
