**ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES**

The court notes that Local Bankruptcy Rule B-9010-1(i) directs attorneys seeking *pro hac vice* admission to practice to use the form available from the clerk of the district court. This form is available from the clerk of the bankruptcy court. Effective immediately, this local rule is amended to delete the reference to the district clerk. As amended, Local Bankruptcy Rule B-9010-1(i) reads as follows:

(i) Persons appearing *pro hac vice* pursuant to subsection (c) of this rule shall certify that they have read the Standards for Professional Conduct within the Seventh Federal Judicial Circuit and the local rules of this court and shall abide by them in all cases in this court. This certification shall accompany the motion to appear *pro hac vice* on the form available from the clerk of court. The failure to make the required certification may result in the motion being denied.
