ORDER AMENDING GENERAL ORDERS

The court finds that changes to two of its standing orders are required. Effective immediately these orders are amended as follows.

1. Technical revisions are made to the Sixth Amended Order Authorizing Electronic Case Filing changing “document(s)” to “paper(s)” in paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 11. Additionally, paragraph 9, Payment of Filing Fees, is deleted and subsequent paragraphs are renumbered accordingly.

2. General Order 2001-02 is amended as follows:

- a. Section 3.3, Reaffirmation of Qualifications, is amended to change the reaffirmation period from three to five years.
- b. Section 4.1 (b) is deleted, and Section 4.1 (a) is renumbered 4.1.
- c. The General Order is recaptioned from General Order 2001-02 to “General Order Regarding Alternative Dispute Resolution.”
