**ORDER RESCINDING LOCAL ADOPTION OF INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES,
RETAINING INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULE 5012 AND
ADOPTING INTERIM RULE 1007-I**

By order dated October 14, 2005, this Court adopted the Interim Bankruptcy Rules promulgated by the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules. Effective December 1, 2008, all Interim Bankruptcy Rules, except for Rule 5012, have been included as part of amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

Accordingly, it is ordered that paragraph A of the Court's Order of October 14, 2005, Adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules is hereby vacated.

It is further ordered that Interim Bankruptcy Rule 5012 shall remain in full force and effect until it is replaced by a permanent national rule, or upon further order of this Court.

It is also further ordered that Interim Rule 1007-I and the associated revision of Official Form 22A, as approved by the Judicial Conference of the United States, are adopted by this Court.
