ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

1. The court takes notice that on January 1, 2012, the district court for this district promulgated amended local rules. Of particular note, the district court changed the numbering nomenclature. Accordingly, the bankruptcy rules that reference district court rules contain technical inaccuracies. The court finds that these references should be corrected and that technical revisions of this nature do not require publication for comment before implementation.

Effective immediately, the local rules of this court are amended as follows:

(A) N.D. Ind. Local Bankruptcy Rule B-1001-1 is amended to read:

(c) These rules shall govern all cases and proceedings referred to bankruptcy judges pursuant to N.D. Ind. L.R. 200-1.

(B) N.D. Ind. Local Bankruptcy Rule B-9010-1 is amended to read as follows:

(d) The provisions of N.D. Ind. L.R. 83-5(a)(3), (d), and (e) are applicable to all matters pending in the bankruptcy court.

The remaining paragraphs of rule B-9010-1 are renumbered as (e), (f), and (g) respectively.

2. The court takes notice that the amended local rules of the district court have eliminated rules concerning discovery in aid of judgment or execution and final orders in wage garnishment. Consequently, Local Bankruptcy Rule B-7069-1 is outdated and no longer required. The court finds that a technical revision of this nature does not require publication for comment before

implementation. Effective immediately, N.D. Ind. Local Bankruptcy Rule B-7069-1 is abrogated.

3. The court also takes notice that the Judicial Conference of the United States has published its policy regarding cameras in the courtroom in the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*. Additionally, the district court has published amended N.D. Ind. L.R. 83-3, Courtroom and Courthouse Decorum, governing this subject. As such, Local Bankruptcy Rule B-5072-1 is outdated and no longer required. The court finds that a technical revision of this nature does not require publication for comment before implementation. Effective immediately, N.D. Ind. Local Bankruptcy Rule B-5072-1 is abrogated.
