1. The second to the last sentence of N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9006-1(a) is amended to read:

In the event opposing counsel does not object to the extension, the party requesting the extension shall document the lack of objection and file notice of the extension.


2. N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9014-2 is redesignated as N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9014-2(a).


3. N.D. Ind. L.B.R. B-9014-2 is amended to add a new paragraph (b) which reads as follows:
