PRESS RELEASE

Chief Judge Diane P. Wood announced that the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit has reappointed Northern Indiana Chief Bankruptcy Judge Robert E. Grant to another 14-year term when his current term expires August 16, 2015. Chief Judge Wood commented that the bar and the public were extensively surveyed and the results were that Chief Bankruptcy Judge Grant is rated an excellent judge.

Chief Bankruptcy Judge Grant was initially sworn in as a bankruptcy judge on August 17, 1987, and was reappointed in 2001. He became Chief Bankruptcy Judge on January 9, 2010, a position he currently holds. Chief Bankruptcy Judge Grant is headquartered in Fort Wayne, Indiana and handles cases filed in the Fort Wayne Division and the Hammond Division at Lafayette.
