ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

Effective December 1, 2009, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will be amended to change the time computation for most deadlines of less than thirty days. Accordingly, the local rules of this court should be amended so that they conform to the new national deadlines. Given that these amendments have been necessitated by changes to the national rules and are needed to avoid conflicting with those rules, they do not require an opportunity for public comment before being adopted. Therefore, effective December 1, 2009, the local rules of this court are amended as follows:

- a. Five-day periods are amended to be seven days.
- b. Eight-day periods are amended to be seven days.
- c. Ten-day periods are amended to be fourteen days.
- d. Fifteen-day periods are amended to be fourteen days.
- e. Twenty-day periods are amended to be twenty-one days.
