ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE

Effective immediately, the local rules of the court are amended as follows.

Local Bankruptcy Rule B-1009-1, Amendments is amended to clarify the requirements needed for amendments and updates the rule to address recent changes to the rules regarding electronic service, and paragraphs (a) and (c) now read:

- a) Amendments to a voluntary petition, list, schedule or statement shall:
- (1) Be made in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1009;
 - (2) Be accompanied by a separate notice of amendment which shall identify the document amended, the general purpose of the amendment, and state the information added, deleted or changed by the amendment;
 - (3) Be verified and signed as in the original document; and
 - (4) Include all information from the original document together with any new information. New information shall be highlighted or otherwise emphasized.
- c) Debtor shall serve a copy of the notice of amendment in accordance with Rule 9013(b) upon those entitled to service (which may include all creditors and parties in interest), including any added creditors, and file proof thereof along with the amendment.
