ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

The court takes notice that certain of its rules contain outdated references that are no longer required or need revision. The court finds that technical revisions of this nature do not require publication for comment before implementation. Effective immediately, the local rules of this court are amended as follows:

Local Bankruptcy Rule B-9029-2, Limitation on Sanctions for Error as to Form, is amended to eliminate the reference to number of copies filed with the court, and now reads:

The court may sanction any attorney or person appearing *pro se* for violation of any local rule governing the form of pleadings and other papers filed with the court by the imposition of a fine not to exceed \$1000.00, or by ordering stricken, after notice and opportunity to be heard or to cure the defect, a paper which does not comply with these Rules. Local rules governing the form of pleadings and other papers filed with the court include, but are not limited to, those local rules regulating the paper size and the requirement of a special designation in the caption.
