ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

Notice of proposed amendments to the local rules of this court was given to the bar and the public on September 24, 2019. The last date for submitting comments concerning the proposed amendments was December 4, 2019, and the court did not receive any comments. Effective immediately, the local rules of the court are amended as follows.

Local Bankruptcy Rule B-7015-1, Amended Pleadings, is amended to delete the last sentence of paragraph b and to add "as an exhibit" before the words "to the motion" in the remaining sentence. That paragraph now reads:

(b) A motion to amend any pleading filed in an adversary proceeding shall attach a copy of the proposed amended pleading as an exhibit to the motion.

Local Bankruptcy Rule B-9013-4, Proof of Service, is amended to address proof of service when a paper is served by filing electronically, and now reads:

(a) No certificate of service is required when a paper is served by filing it with the court's electronic filing system. For service other than through the court's electronic filing system, in addition to identifying the pleading, motion or other paper served and showing the date upon which service was made, every proof of service or certificate of service shall state the name of every entity served and the address to which service was directed, together with the manner in which service was made.
