The Court will make reasonable accommodations for deaf and hearing-impaired participants that have proceedings before the court in accordance with Judicial Conference Policy. Participants in a court proceeding may include parties, attorneys or witnesses. Accommodations include sign language interpretation and assisted listening device equipment that will increase the volume of the sound system during court proceedings. If a hearing is conducted in a virtual format, the closed captioning option may be utilized to display the spoken word for hearing impaired participants.
