Expenses of Chapter 13 Trustees

Amended General Order 2001-03

The court has reviewed the amount of the administrative expenses of Chapter 13 Trustees at the request of the United States Trustee and the Chapter 13 Trustees. The court finds good cause has been shown to adjust the amount last set by the court in 2002.

Accordingly, the Chapter 13 Trustees shall be entitled to reimbursement of the following administrative expenses without the need for a motion, notice, hearing, or further order of the court:

1. Whenever the Chapter 13 Trustee is directed to serve a proposed Chapter 13 plan and an order fixing the deadline for filing objections thereto, the Trustee shall automatically be allowed an expense in the sum of \$3.50 per notice served, per case, on account of the costs associated with the copying, mailing, and service of the plan and notice, and making proof thereof.
2. Whenever a Chapter 13 case is dismissed or converted prior to confirmation of a proposed plan, the Chapter 13 Trustee shall automatically be entitled to the reimbursement of costs in the sum of \$50.00, in addition to the expenses set out in paragraph (1) above.

This order shall be effective as of October 1, 2012 as to all cases, whether filed before or after the date of this order. The court will periodically review the amount of these administrative expenses at the request of the United States Trustee.
